Subject: 2024 Community Tree Program

Summary Statement: Healthy trees provide benefits in reducing potential impacts of urban stormwater runoff. Trees also provide benefits in adapting to climate change. The Council authorized a one-time \$100k expenditure from the Surface and Stormwater Fund for tree planting in the community to accrue those benefits and make progress towards the goals in the Climate Action Plan. The 2024 Community Tree Program will use the authorized funding to support tree planting efforts across Bellingham and includes coupons for trees at local nurseries, partnerships with local nonprofit organizations, and neighborhood associations, providing trees directly to residents at no cost and other educational efforts.

Fiscal Impact: Funding for \$100,000 2024 program is included the adopted 2023-2024 Budget
