Subject: **Post Point Resource Recovery Updates and Biosolids Beneficial Use Request for Proposals (RFP) Results**

Summary Statement: Work on the Post Point Resource Recovery Project continues to advance. Digestion was previously selected as the preferred alternative. The Digestion process will produce a Class A biosolids for potential beneficial use. A request for proposal for Biosolids Beneficial Use Services (RFP 54B-2021) was issued at the end of 2021 to seek service providers interested in providing information related to the future transporting, processing, and beneficially using and/or marketing products derived from Class A dewatered biosolids. Two proposals were submitted. The proposals are posted on the project website at: <https://cob.org/project/resourcerecovery>. Staff will provide a brief overview and summarize next steps. Also included is a short summary on project impacts on rates.
